Later, the film was presented to a larger audience at Griffith University's Nathan campus, Queensland, Australia, hosted by Women Empowerment & Leadership, a Brisbane-based organization dedicated to advocating for women's rights and leadership."The Dark Future" continued its journey, receiving official selection by the Ghan International Film Festival 2024 in Australia. The film was screened for public audiences and invited guests at Event Cinemas Parramatta in Sydney on the 9th and 10th of November, 2024. Upcoming screenings are scheduled at Mercury Cinema in Adelaide on the 23rd and 24th of November, 2024.
